Besides above, PET survey for 14 Metro corridors has been sanctioned/announced in the Budget speech. The PET surveys for all corridors have been awarded to M/S. RITES. The status of submission of reports for the corridors is as under.

Now, a situation is on the surface where we can see that the progress of the construction of Metro extension work is either stopped or very slow due to different impediments. The reasons for bottlenecks in the construction are to be sorted out first. The State Govt. may also be approached for playing its appropriate role as it is a matter of development work of the state also. We apprehend the projects will be only in the drawing board, unless, a pressure is created to implement the work into reality. In this regard, our Union is ready to come forward.
