Dear Comrade,

***Sub: Fixation of Pay of Commercial Porters & Safaiwalas –
Ex-contractual workmen.***

You are well aware that out of 650 ex-contractual workmen only 400 Nos. are deprived of Rs. 1800/- GP. Except Rs. 1800 GP, they have been enjoying all the privileges of a regular employee. The Metro Administration also vide letter Nos. MRTS/E326/0/Rctt(Group-D)/Pt . 1 dated 05-8-2015 have certified their sufficient work experience & training during last 5 years and requested for granting GP Rs. 1800/-.

The matter was raised by AIRF in the PNM in 2014. In the last PNM held on 02/6 & 3/6/2016 this issue was deliberated at length and was decided to set right the issue at the earliest.


Now, the Gazette Notification for implementation of 7th CPC has been issued showing the Pay Matrix from the minimum of pay of Rs. 7000/- (Rs. 18000/- in the new matrix).

It is mentioned that most of the CP & SW has reached the basic to Rs. 6,880/- in the IS scale of Rs. 4440-7440/- with grade pay Rs. 1300/- (i.e Rs. 20/- short of Rs. 7000/-) in PB Rs. 5200-20,000 with GP 1800/- the minimum pay for availing the bottom pay of the 7th CPC is Rs. 18000/-. For just short of Rs. 20/- in the minimum pay they may be deprived. Special dispensation from the Board is required to alleviate the resentment of this section of employees.

In view of above, you are requested to approach the appropriate authority fixation of Pay of Commercial Porters & Safaiwalas – Ex-contractual workmen of Metro Railway.
