As per the Railway Board's letter (Reference (i)), the authority to prepare the Accident Manual was given to COM. Railway Board nominated Safety Officers for departments connected with Safety, since it is multi-disciplinary in nature, vide reference (ii) above. The Board have reviewed the existing practice for preparation of Accident Manual and decided that henceforth its preparation and updation should be transferred from the office of PCOM to PCSO. PCSOs of Zonal Railways are therefore advised to undertake the work of preparation and updation of Accident Manual, in consultation with Nodal officers of different departments.
